Student Code of Conduct

1. Students are expected to honor God, their parents, their country, their instructor(s), and their fellow students, according to biblical principles of conduct.
2. Students are expected to act respectfully toward all church/school staff, students, facilities, and property. Any disrespect in word or in action will be dealt with immediately.
3. Students may eat food only in designated areas during breaks and during lunch period.
4. Students are expected to know and comply with the Veritas dress code. Students dressed inappropriately may be required to call their parents for a change of clothes before being allowed to participate in class.
5. Students are expected to arrive on time, have all assignments completed, and be prepared to participate in each class discussion, activity and instruction.
6. Students are expected to be honest and original in all assignments. Plagiarism or cheating of any kind will not be tolerated and may result in a zero grade for an assignment.
7. Students are responsible for submitting all missed work due to illness or other excused absences within two weeks of the due date. Work submitted later than two weeks after the date it was due may result in a zero grade for the assignment. Work submitted late other than for an excused absence may be subject to penalty by the teacher. See class syllabus for any modifications to this policy.
8. Students are expected to have all mobile devices (phones, watches, games, etc.) turned off and put away during the school day as well as lunchtime. A student using a device during school hours may have it taken away until the end of the school day. Teachers may modify this policy at their discretion.
